We then, after the sudden closure of the Out of School experience at Osbaldeston school, made the decision to continue this provision for our families, using our own staff and making sure our children had a home-from-home experience at the start/end of the day. The wraparound care is not a profit making venture, but is simply there to provide a service to our working/busy families. Please do sign up to use the club if this would help you or your child. We are

happy to take ad-hoc, one-off bookings for your child/children as long as they are registered with Mrs Johnstone. Please ask Mrs Johnstone for a sign up sheet and then you can ring and book a place at any time. The children are particularly enjoying the sports clubs in the mornings, with archery, tennis, dodgeball games etc. We have also held a huge board games competition this week in after-school club!
