Sports Day - Monday 19th June 1pm



Next Monday afternoon is our school sports afternoon - hopefully the weather will be kind and somewhat cooler than this week. Just a reminder of the way the day works and a warm welcome to our parents who will be attending sports day for the very first time.

The children can come to school wearing their coloured t-shirt (list attached for reference). Please don't go out and buy a t-shirt - just wear one closest to the shade of your child's house team. They can get changed into their shorts/leggings before lunch. The children need to wear - their black shorts/leggings, trainers and their coloured t-shirt. Please apply suncream, bring a hat and/or a lightweight waterproof jacket and make sure the children have their water bottle in school (we shall still go out if it is a bit showery!) Parents/carers - bring a camping chair/picnic blanket so you can relax whilst you watch and cheer!

The children will have an early lunch at 11.45am and then we'll be ready to start our sports at 1pm. Parents please make your way to the field (through the junior gate) where we shall parade out and meet you.

The children are in a team with their siblings etc and they will take part in a carousel of games and parents will follow their child's team as they rotate around the activities. Then, we shall have our traditional races (including parent and toddler races - so wear your trainers). We shall have refreshments for the children available as one of the activities - so you don't need to bring extra snacks! Please do not encourage your child to leave the racetrack side during the races section of the afternoon, as we need to know that all the children are safe and together.

Pre-schoolers are **ALL** welcome to sports day afternoon (even if it is not their usual day). We do ask that parents accompany their pre-schoolers as they go around the activities. Our Reception and pre-school children will all have a year 6 buddy to help them enjoy their first sports day.

Arty Adah's Art club - Alpaca adventure




